



Greetings Skiers and Riders!

Welcome to Camp Bluebird! On behalf of Pajarito Mountain we'd like to express how excited we are to have you participate in this special program. Camp Bluebird is a coordinated effort by the entire Ski Area. This includes Administration, Lifts, Café, Mountain Operations and SnowSports School.

Pajarito Mountain's objective for Camp Bluebird is to enhance your child's passion for winter, outdoor recreational activities they may enjoy for a lifetime (be it skiing or snowboarding). In order to achieve this objective, we'd like to clarify some important points.

Please read the following guidelines carefully. Ultimately the success of the program will depend on the close coordination and cooperation of parents, children and Pajarito Mountain Staff.

- Our gathering place is the popup tent near the base of the magic carpet.
- Those with their own equipment should check in at the gathering place no later than 9:30 A.M. Lessons start promptly at 10:00 A.M.
- Those renting equipment need to be at the rental shop no later than 8:30 A.M., preferably 8:00 A.M. Once you have your rental gear, check in at the gathering place no later than 9:30 A.M. Lessons start promptly at 10:00 A.M.
- Group assignments will begin at 10:00 A.M. the first day. These assignments are ability based. Friends and family members may be separated because of age or ability.
- Please communicate to the Camp Bluebird staff any medical or special needs your child may require. Note that we may not be able to accommodate all special needs.

- Pajarito Mountain Café will provide lunch each day. The lunch consists of one entrée and a drink. Pajarito Mountain Café is unable to accommodate special diets. If your child requires a special diet you may send a lunch with your child. Please do not include any form of nuts or nut products! We are a nut-free program.
- It is possible that Children enrolled in Camp BlueBird lessons may not always ride with an instructor on the chairlift. Children may ride chairlifts with other members of the skiing/riding public, Pajarito Mountain staff, other children without an adult on the chair, or by themselves.
- We do not issue refunds due to weather, snow conditions, when children are unwilling to participate or if children become ill while, or after, being in our care.
- If a problem should arise with a student in a Camp Bluebird lesson, on-mountain communication will be in the form of message board at the bottom of critical lifts. We will also contact you by cell phone. Parents are expected to promptly report to the Camp Bluebird gathering place should a problem arise with your child.
- Instructors release Camp Bluebird students promptly at 3:00 pm. Parents are expected to be at the Camp Bluebird gathering place at that time.

Again, we are thrilled you have chosen to participate in this special program. Camp Bluebird was designed with families like you in mind. We are delighted that you have chosen Pajarito Mountain. At the conclusion of Camp Bluebird, we hope your child loves snowsports as we do!
